Dear Professor Capps:


With the concurrence of Dean Kenneth P. Goodrich and Vice Chancellor John James Prucha, it is my pleasure to offer you a one-semester temporary term appointment to a position as Visiting Professor of Religion in the Department of Religion, College of Arts and Sciences, at Syracuse University. This appointment will begin September 1, 1975. Your salary in this position will be \$12,000 for the semester which ends December 31, 1975. It will be paid in semi-monthly installments and will be subject to deductions for State and Federal Income Taxes and for membership in the Social Security System.

The Department of Religion will be responsible for your personal travel, not in excess of \$500, from Santa Barbara, California to Syracuse, New York, and return.

Your teaching load will entail two courses. The first will be a large undergraduate lecture course; the second will be a graduate seminar with an enrollment of no more than 18 students. You will be asked to present a public lecture to the Syracuse University community and to participate in such symposia or colloquia as the department might sponsor during the semester.


If you will accept appointment as described above, please sign and return the three enclosed carbon copies of this letter. You may, of course, keep the original letter for your files.
