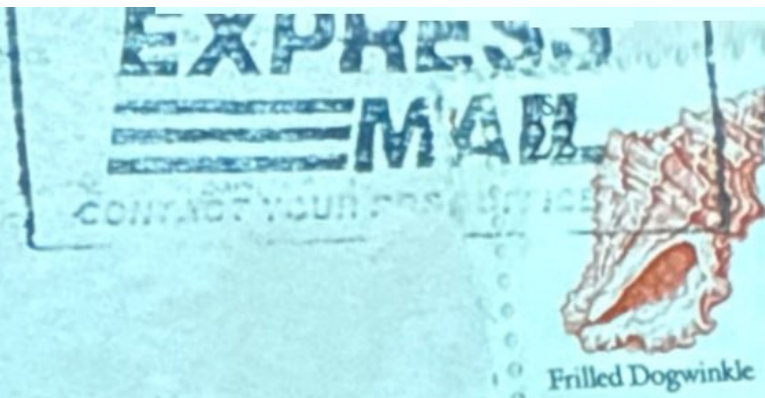


DALLAS, TEXAS
