He would like to speak about his frustrations, bitterness, hostility; watching the problems his mother had, etc. Particularly, he would like to talk about the government's seeming unwillingness to help trace the MIAs. (He claims there is reliable info that approximately 450 MIAs are still alive and now in China.)

He thinks he can contribute because his experience is the same that the VIetnam MIA children are now going through - and he can inform the class of this legacy of the Korean/Vietnam war.

He has a nice speaking voice - and speaks well - and doesn't sound like a kook. (I told him you already had speakers lined up, etc. but that I would mention his case to you.)
