

GEORGE MCGOVERN TO TEACH AT UCSB

George McGovern, the Democratic Party's presidential nominee in 1972, will help teach an undergraduate course at UCSB in the winter quarter.

The course, Religion and Politics in America Today, is co-sponsored by the political science and religious studies departments and will be co-taught by Walter Capps, professor of religious studies.

McGovern, who lost his Senate seat from South Dakota last year, is a former professor and the son of a minister. He is critical of the role of fundamentalist religious movements in contemporary politics.

The course will bring representatives of such movements to the classroom to give their side of the issue.
